

Unlocking UK's Heritage: An Educational Adventure in London, Oxford & Cambridge



This 7-day educational tour is designed for international students aged 13–18 interested in history, culture, and top UK universities. Participants explore major landmarks, attend guided tours of Oxford and Cambridge, and immerse themselves in British academic and cultural life.

Itinerary Overview

Day 1 – Arrival in London

- Airport pickup from Heathrow/Gatwick/Stansted
- Hotel check-in and welcome dinner
- Evening walking tour near hotel (e.g., Tower Bridge or Westminster area)

Day 2 – Historic London

- Visit to the Tower of London with guided history tour
- Thames River Cruise
- British Museum guided session
- Dinner at Leicester Square



Day 3 – University of Oxford

- Coach to Oxford (1.5 hours)
- Walking tour: Bodleian Library, Radcliffe Camera, Christ Church College
- Free time for lunch and shopping
- Return to London



Day 4 – Royal & Political London

Guided visit to Westminster Abbey

Walking tour of Parliament Square

Visit to Churchill War Rooms



Day 5 – University of Cambridge



- Coach to Cambridge (1.5 hours)
- Guided visit: King's College, Mathematical Bridge, University museums
- Optional punting activity
- Return to London

Day 6 – Cultural London & West End



Morning: Natural History or Science Museum



Afternoon: Free time for shopping (Oxford Street/Covent Garden)



Evening: West End Musical (e.g., Matilda or Lion King)

Day 7 – Departure

- Free time depending on flight schedule
- Airport transfers to any London airport
- End of programme
